Itawamba Community College is the fastest growing and most progressive community college in Mississippi.

In the past 10 years, ICC has invested more than \$60 million in new buildings and technology to ensure that students have the latest computer innovations, the most advanced classrooms to enhance their learning experience and the most modern buildings, athletic facilities and residence halls.

ICC serves Chickasaw, Itawamba, Lee, Monroe and Pontotoc counties, but its provision of online classes extends its boundaries to the region, state and nation.

Itawamba Community College's tuition is one of the lowest; its scholarship program is one of the best in Mississippi and it was the first in the state for all five of its supporting counties to provide guaranteed tuition for all of their high school seniors beginning with the class of 2009.
